**Day 1: Sunday, July 25, 2027 Overnight Flight** Begin your journey to a land of mountains, glacial fjords, legends, and charming people, as you set off for Norway. Dive into the culture of the region, connecting with layers of Viking history, attention-grabbing nature, and a sense of refined traditions.

**Day 2: Monday, July 26, 2027 Bergen, Norway** Arrive in Bergen, in the heart of the fjords, where you'll be greeted by small-town charm despite it being the second largest city in Norway. With no scheduled activities throughout the afternoon, enjoy time to explore Bergen independently. Meet your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in the historic Bryggen neighborhood. (D)

**Day 3: Tuesday, July 27, 2027 Bergen** Stroll along the historic and iconic Bryggen harbor front (UNESCO) on a guided walking tour of Bergen. Vibrant hues of historic wooden buildings and the salty sea breeze blends as you gain a sense of this area's long maritime history. The rest of the day is yours to explore Bergen at your leisure. (B)

**Day 4: Wednesday, July 28, 2027 Bergen - Loen** Heading north this morning, take in the striking scenery along your journey today. Stop for lunch in a village along the way, and continue to the Nordfjord Folk Museum, an open-air cultural history museum depicting how Norwegians have lived from the 17th century to the modern day. Later, arrive at the hotel for a relaxing evening and dinner. (B, D)

**Day 5: Thursday, July 29, 2027 Loen** Find yourself immersed in the enchanting landscapes of Norway's fjord region. Soak up the mesmerizing landscape on an exhilarating Geirangerfjord cruise in Geiranger (UNESCO). Discover Norway's mightiest waterfalls – the Seven Sisters, the Bridal Veil, and the Sutor. Marvel at the homesteads built along the steep sides of the mountains, where farmland has endured for centuries. (B, D)

**Day 6: Friday, July 30, 2027 Loen - Flåm** Reach great heights with today's adventures. This morning, ride the Loen Skylift, one of the world's steepest cable cars, for unrivaled views of the fjord landscape. Continue to the quaint village of Flåm, your gateway to the grandeur of Aulandsfjord. Traverse the terrain on the renowned Flåm Railway, one of the steepest train rides in the world, and climb 3000 feet past rushing waterfalls, looming mountains, and picturesque valleys. Descend back into Flåm for your stay tonight. (B, D)

**Day 7: Saturday, July 31, 2027 Flåm - Oslo** Norway's impressive landscapes continue to weave their spell on you as you travel to Oslo today. On the way, visit the Borgund Stave Church, an awe-inspiring building dedicated in honor of Apostle Andrew in 1180. After a stop for lunch, continue to Norway's grand capital and enjoy an evening at leisure. (B)

**Day 8: Sunday, August 1, 2027 Oslo** This morning, join a local guide and begin your day at the Fram Museum, dedicated to telling the story of Norwegian polar exploration. Venture down Karl Johan Street, passing iconic buildings such as the Royal Palace and city hall, as you take in the charming heart of downtown Oslo. This afternoon, enjoy free time to relax or continue discovering the hidden gems of Oslo on your own. Tonight, toast to your Norwegian adventure with your fellow travelers during a farewell dinner featuring traditional fare in one of Oslo's oldest buildings. (B, D)

**Day 9: Monday, August 2, 2027 Oslo - Tour Ends** Say *ha det* to Norway and depart for home with incredible memories of your adventures. (B)

You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. Expect some full days balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

### Day 9: Oslo - Reykjavik, Iceland

Discover Iceland, a land and culture forged by fire and ice, where steaming lava fields reflect its volcanic nature, while massive glaciers carve mountains and valleys, creating thundering waterfalls and breathtaking landscapes. Upon arrival, meet your Icelandic Tour Manager and join an orientation walk of the city. After some free time to explore on your own, gather with your fellow travelers and enjoy an Icelandic dinner at a popular local restaurant. *Today dinner will be included.*

### Day 10: Reykjavik

This morning, join your Tour Manager for a walking tour of the city's historic center featuring Hallgrímskirkja church, City Hall, the harbor, and Reykjavik's oldest building, home of the Kraum Icelandic design center. The remainder of the day is yours to explore at leisure. Perhaps venture to one of Iceland's renowned geothermal spas for a relaxing soak in the mineral rich waters of the famous Blue Lagoon, set among dramatic lava fields, or visit the oceanfront Sky Lagoon for sweeping views and its signature geothermal bathing ritual. You may also choose to head out on a thrilling whale-watching cruise from Reykjavik's harbor or learn about Iceland's powerful volcanic forces at the fascinating Lava Show. *Today breakfast will be included.*

### Day 11: Reykjavik - Golden Circle - Reykjavik

Travel the incredible Golden Circle, a route encompassing many of Iceland's renowned natural wonders. Marvel at Gullfoss (Golden Falls) waterfall, a spectacular 100-foot double cascade. Continue to Thingvellir National Park, Iceland's most historic site, where in A.D. 930 Icelanders established what's considered one of the world's first parliaments. Stand upon one of the globe's most geologically significant landscapes, Thingvellir's rugged rift valley (UNESCO), marking the crest of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge where the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates meet. Return to Reykjavik with time to explore the city on your own. *Today breakfast will be included.*

### Day 12: Reykjavik - Extension Ends

Your extension ends today. *Today breakfast will be included.*

### Important Tour Extension Information:

**The overall activity level of this extension is a level 2.** This means you can partake in a two-hour walking tour covering up to 2 miles (including breaks), over a variety of terrains. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease and handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet. While this level is appropriate for travelers that require mobility assistance devices, there could be times when you may have to sit out on some of the included activities.

**Fully-guided** extensions are a great way to explore a new destination. Enjoy sightseeing and local experiences led by a Tour Manager or local expert.

We reserve the right to cancel this extension if a minimum of 6 travelers is not met to operate.

Summer temperatures in Iceland are cool and variable, typically ranging from the mid-40s to the low-60s°F. Weather can change quickly. Sunshine, wind, and rain may all occur on the same day. Expect strong coastal winds and cooler conditions near waterfalls, glaciers, and the ocean. Weather conditions on the water are colder and windier than on land.

Daylight hours are very long (up to 20+ hours), which can affect sleep. Eye masks are recommended.

Most natural sites, such as waterfalls, beaches, glaciers, and lava fields, require walking on unpaved, uneven surfaces rendered slippery by ice and rain. Sturdy footwear and waterproof jackets are required if you plan to walk in these areas or approach the waterfalls. Your safety is our priority. Please always stay on marked paths and follow the Tour Manager's instructions.

On occasion, some activities may not be available due to inclement weather.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by the observance of religious/local holidays or seasonal closures.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Due to flight schedules, a post night may be required in some Icelandair gateway cities (at an additional cost). Please inquire at time of reservation.
