

Delores M. Andy Scholarship

Through a generous contribution in 2007, Delores M. Andy, Professor Emerita, Temple University, supported the establishment of this award. The purpose is to support the attendance of one Temple University undergraduate student from the School of Tourism and Hospitality Management, with emphasis on community and urban recreation, to the Annual PRPS State Conference.

Delores Andy enjoyed a long, distinguished 46-year career serving the students and programs of Temple University and the citizens of the City of Philadelphia. In 1974, she began her career at Temple



University as the Director of the Joint Recreation Resources Department and by 1997; she became a Full Professor in the Department of Sport Management and Leisure Studies. Her specialty was working with students and she was a leader who understood the value and importance of having students attend the annual PRPS State Conference.

The Delores Andy Scholarship Award includes: Full Conference Registration, meals and lodging at the PRPS Conference & Expo and Scholarship Certificate.

Scholarship qualifications:

- 1. PRPS Member; Full-time Temple University undergraduate student in Recreation and Parks; must be a full-time student at the time of the Conference
- 2. Must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or equivalent
- 3. Outstanding involvement in extra-curricular activities
